**280,000** liters of safe drinking water delivered to **56,000** individuals



### EMERGENCY SHELTER:

**472** tarpaulins provided emergency shelter support for **2,832** people



### WINTER RELIEF:

**472** blankets, **392** jackets, and **477** winter kits (hats, scarves, and socks) distributed



### EDUCATION SUPPORT:

**500** school stationery bags distributed to students

### Situation Update – Aid Challenges

The humanitarian crisis in Gaza remains catastrophic despite the fragile October 2025 ceasefire. Fuel shortages, electricity blackouts, and soaring food prices have deepened suffering as families become increasingly dependent on aid. Around 1.6 million people face acute food insecurity while damaged infrastructure, overcrowded shelters, and shortages of medicine and clean water heighten risks of disease and malnutrition.
