Total Beneficiaries: 77,101



FOOD PARCEL DISTRIBUTION:

1,300 food packages with essential dry goods and staples nourished **6,500 individuals**.



CLEAN WATER DISTRIBUTION:

350,000 liters of clean water delivered to **70,000 individuals**.



PEDIATRIC & DENTAL CLINIC:

243 patients treated through our mobile pediatric and dental clinic services.



VOCATIONAL SKILLS TRAINING:

A 12-day hairdressing training program completed by **10 participants**.



HEALTH OUTREACH:

8 field screenings & health awareness lectures reached **348 community members**.

Situation Update – Aid Challenges

With most of the population confined to less than half of the territory amid ongoing military operations near the “Yellow Line,” families faced extreme overcrowding in shelters, inadequate sanitation, and critical water shortages while infectious diseases such as chickenpox, acute watery diarrhea, and respiratory infections spread rapidly.

Despite these immense challenges, **we remained committed** to delivering clean water, mobile healthcare, and life-saving assistance, helping protect the health, dignity, and resilience of Gaza’s most vulnerable families.
