



Situation Report: Emergency Humanitarian Relief

Impact Report | Reporting Period: January 2026

Highlights



Relief distributions were conducted at **45 locations** across Gaza.



Winter relief items, including blankets, jackets, and winter sets, were delivered to **981 vulnerable individuals**.



240,000 liters of clean water were distributed to **48,000 people**.



Emergency shelter materials, including tents and tarpaulins, provided safe spaces for **1,710 people**.

Situation Update – Aid Challenges

The humanitarian crisis in Gaza remains catastrophic despite the October 2025 ceasefire. Families face ongoing sporadic violence, severe restrictions on aid and movement, and widespread deprivation. Around 1.6 million people experience high acute food insecurity, including children and pregnant or breastfeeding women at risk of malnutrition. Thousands remain displaced, living in damaged homes or shelters, enduring winter cold, collapsed health services, water shortages, disease outbreaks, and protection risks.
