Highlights



Our distributions took place at **26 locations** with local partners.

Winter relief items were distributed to **2,840 people** in North Gaza and Gaza City.

172,00 liters of clean water was distributed in **16 locations** Mawasi, Gaza City, North Gaza and Khan Younis

HOT MEALS:

2,000 meals were distributed, reaching **4,000 individuals**



FOOD PARCELS:

293 parcels distributed, reaching **1,758 individuals**



CLEAN WATER DISTRIBUTION:

172,000 liters of safe drinking water delivered to **34,400 individuals**



HEALTHCARE ASSISTANCE:

197 patients received medical treatments



EMERGENCY SHELTER:

226 tarpaulins sheltered **1,130 people**



WINTER RELIEF:

1,710 received winter blankets and coats



Situation Update – Aid Challenges

The humanitarian crisis in Gaza remains catastrophic as millions remain displaced; many are living in damaged homes, tents, or overcrowded shelters, facing freezing temperatures, flooding, and destroyed infrastructure. Food insecurity affects over 1.6 million people, including tens of thousands of children and pregnant or breastfeeding women at risk of acute malnutrition. Health facilities operate at half capacity; water and sanitation are scarce, and winter storms have worsened living conditions. Yet with your support, our teams are providing life-saving assistance and working tirelessly to safeguard lives, ease suffering, and restore hope for families struggling to survive in this ongoing crisis.
