HIGHLIGHTS



Mobile pediatric and dental clinics

brought essential healthcare services directly to communities across Gaza.



A livelihood training program

equipped participants with practical vocational and entrepreneurial skills to support long-term economic resilience.



We delivered **30,000 liters**

of clean drinking water to help prevent waterborne diseases and protect community health.

HEALTH OUTREACH:

8 field screenings and **6 health awareness lectures** conducted, reaching **635 community members**.



PEDIATRIC & DENTAL CLINIC:

731 patients treated through our mobile pediatric and dental clinic services.



VOCATIONAL SKILLS TRAINING:

A 12-day hairdressing training program completed by **10 participants**.



CLEAN WATER DISTRIBUTION:

30,000 liters of clean water delivered to **6,000 individuals**.
