Highlights



Our **distributions** took place at **29 locations** with local partners.



5 Tent mosques were established across **Mawasi, Khan Younis**: in Al-Iqlimi, Safad Camp, near the Turkish Slaughterhouse, by Well 19, and on Al-Attar Street.



Our **multi-week food parcels** sustained displaced families with essential staples of **rice, lentils, flour, sugar, oil, and proteins**.
