Highlights



Our distributions took place at 29 locations with local partners.



5 Tent mosques were established across Mawasi, Khan Younis: in Al-Iqlimi, Safad Well 19, and on Al-Attar Street.



Our multi-week food parcels sustained displaced families with essential staples of rice, lentils, flour, sugar, oil, and proteins.

10,000 meals were distributed, reaching 20,000 individuals

2,000 parcels distributed, reaching 12,000 beneficiaries

500,000 liters of safe drinking water delivered to 100.000 individuals



HEALTHCARE ASSISTANCE:

364 patients received medical treatments



TENT MOSQUES:

5 established, serving 2,500 congregants
