HIGHLIGHTS



Zakat Foundation of America is operating daily food distributions with local partners in various camps in Khan Yunis and Sheikh Radwan.



Since October 2023, **2.9 million liters of clean water** and **2.7 million meals** have been provided by Zakat Foundation of America.



Zakat Foundation of America served 73,600 people with humanitarian aid in July 2025.

HOT MEALS:

45 large pots of food were distributed, reaching **22,500** beneficiaries



VEGETABLE PARCELS:

1,500 parcels distributed, reaching **9,000** beneficiaries



HEALTH CARE ASSISTANCE:

100 patients received medical treatments



CLEAN WATER DISTRIBUTION:

180,000 liters of safe drinking water delivered to **36,000** individuals



FIREWOOD DISTRIBUTION:

25,000 bundles distributed, benefiting **15,000** individuals



SITUATION UPDATE

Aid Challenges

Gaza Strip's infrastructure, healthcare, food security, education, and essential services continue to deteriorate as of July 2025. Relief Web reports that 100% of residents face high levels of acute food insecurity, while 92% of children aged 6-23 months and pregnant women fail to meet basic nutrient requirements. Over 1 million children require mental health and psycho-social support. Meanwhile, more than 658,000 school-aged children lack access to formal learning, as the Gaza Ministry of Education reports over 16,300 students and 721 educational staff have lost their lives.
