HIGHLIGHTS



Zakat Foundation of America provided **critical surgical equipment and support** to the Kuwait Specialty Field Hospital in South Gaza



Since October 2023, **2.7 million liters of clean water** has been provided by **Zakat Foundation of America**



One tent mosque was completed to restore spiritual and social stability, providing dignified, accessible prayer spaces for displaced communities.

HOT MEALS:

75 large pots of food were distributed, reaching **12,000** beneficiaries



VEGETABLE PARCELS:

2,000 parcels distributed, reaching **12,000** beneficiaries



HEALTH CARE ASSISTANCE:

100 patients received medical treatments



CLEAN WATER DISTRIBUTION:

300,000 liters of safe drinking water delivered to **60,000** individuals



FIREWOOD DISTRIBUTION:

25,000 bundles distributed, benefiting **15,000** individuals

Aid Challenges

As of June 2025, over **1 million** Gaza residents face emergency levels of food insecurity, worsened by severely restricted access to humanitarian aid. According to OCHA, **92%** of homes have been damaged, causing ongoing displacement and deepening the humanitarian crisis.
