HIGHLIGHTS



Emergency and medical relief provided across **North Darfur, Central Darfur, and Eastern Chad.**



1,000 displaced families from El Fasher to Tawila in Darfur **received food, blankets, and tents.**



Flood-affected communities in Jabal Marra given essentials.



Our Health Tent in Adré, provides **monthly medical care** to over **1,100 patients.**



Core Relief Items (CRIs) distributed to **286 refugee families** in Chad.

FOOD PARCELS

2,500 parcels distributed, reaching **13,200 beneficiaries**



HEALTH CARE ASSISTANCE

4,300 patients received medical treatments



CORE RELIEF ITEMS

1,430 refugees and displaced people received items for hygiene and shelter



SHELTER & NON-FOOD ITEMS

1,800 blankets, 1,800 cooking sets, and **1,000 tents** distributed to displaced families



ORPHAN CARE

222 orphans supported (**76 in Sudan, 146 in Libya**)



SITUATION UPDATE

Aid Challenges

Humanitarian access across Sudan and Eastern Chad remains severely restricted. Families in North Darfur face acute shortages of food, clean water, and medical care, while floods in Jabal Marra continue to isolate communities. Refugee camps in Chad are overcrowded, heightening risks of cholera, malaria, and malnutrition. Despite these barriers, we remain committed to delivering life-saving food, shelter, and health assistance to vulnerable families.
